School Card

School Card is available to families with children aged four years and over who attend a school full-time. If your school fees are less than the School Card subsidy, the scheme can also help with other educational expenses such as uniform, camp and excursion costs.

The tables below list the income limits for applications lodged in 2020 - based on the family's combined gross income in 2018/2019. To qualify for school card, your family's gross income must be below a certain limit. This limit depends on how many dependent children you have. You will need to provide proof of income -

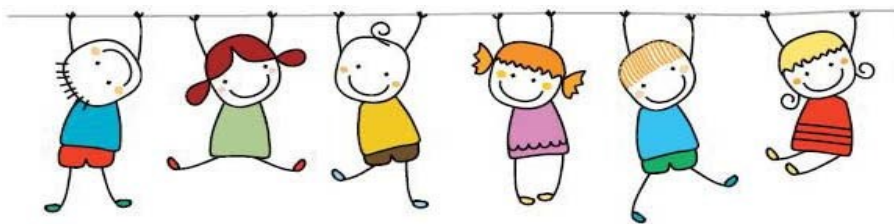
